By signing this form, I/We\* give explicit consent to The Scout Association during and beyond my child's involvement with the organisation:

1. Retaining personal data to facilitate any present or potential future involvement with scouting.
2. Retaining personal data regarding to religion, special needs/disability, ethnicity, medical information and/or commission of offenders or alleged offences.
3. Allowing access to personal data to appropriate individuals within the hierarchy of scouting.
4. Storing the details provided on Online Scout Manager which is a 3<sup>rd</sup> party management system.

Note: The medical profession takes the view that the parent's consent to medical treatment cannot be delegated, as in the Children's Act 1989. Thus this medical consent has no legal status and a medical professional insisting on a parent's consent to a particular treatment has the right to do so. For this reason the Scout Association cannot insist on parents/guardians signing the above statement and you may strike through it. However, it can be a comfort to medical staff to have consent in advance from parents, and thus a leader on hand able to sign forms required by the medical authorities.

No responsibility for personal equipment, clothing and effects can be accepted by the organisers and The Scout Association does not provide insurance cover in respect to such items.
